PLEASE NOTE:

- Each horse and rider **combination** may only compete in ONE HEIGHT CLASS, providing they sign the waiver stating they have the ability to compete at this height.
- Multiple horse and rider combinations are allowed
- If any rider does not sign the waiver or if under 18 have a parent or guardian NOT sign the waiver they may not compete.

THE VENUE:

- The Australian Sporting Equine Academy, built and run by Adam Wootten is located in the picturesque Yarra Valley, and boasts its own 60x40metre indoor facility, 70x30 metre outdoor arena as well as a large grass arena incorporating the Hickstead course. It also provides a large parking area with easy access, wash bays, 14 yards and full catering will be available on the day of competition for all patrons.

THE CLASSES:

The competition is a combination of 3 compulsory classes:

AM7

A competition judged under Table A not against the clock with a time allowed in the first round. The competitor who incurs any jumping or time penalties in the first round has to leave the arena immediately upon completion of the round. The competitor with a clear round must remain in the arena for a jump off against the clock. When the judge rings the bell again, the competitor has another 45 seconds to pass the starting line for the jump off. Should the competitor fail to pass the starting line within the 45 sec., he/she will be eliminated. In case of equality of faults in the jump-off, the jump-off is insufficient to fill the placing's competitors with the less faults and the fastest time of the first round will fill up these places.

Article 274 COMPETITION IN TWO PHASES (POWER AND SPEED)

This competition comprises two phases run without interruption, each at an identical or different speed, the finishing line for the first phase being identical with the starting line for the second phase. The first phase is a course of 8 to 9 obstacles with or without combinations. The second phase takes place over 4 to 6 obstacles, which may include one combination. Competitors penalised in the first phase are halted by ringing the bell after they have jumped the last obstacle or when the time allowed for the first phase has been exceeded, after crossing the finishing line of the first phase. They must stop after crossing the first finishing line. Competitors not penalised in the first phase continue the course, which finishes, after crossing the second finishing line.

The manner of judging this competition must be specified in the schedule in accordance with the following formula:

First phase Second phase Placing

5.2. Table A Table A According to the penalties

Not against the clock Against the clock and time in the second Phase and, if necessary, to the penalties in the first phase.

Competitors stopped after the first phase may only be placed after competitors who have taken part in both phases. In the event of equality for first place, the tied competitors will be placed equal first.

AM5

A competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of faults for 1st place, there will be one jump off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their fault and time in the first round. Competitors must leave the course after the first round and will be recalled in at the completion of the round for the jump off.

MAX HEIGHT / SPREAD FOR EACH OF THE CLASSES:

This event is run under OPEN Rules. Gear is to be as per EFA rules and is judged under FEI Rules.

CLASS 1 may not run if numbers do not permit. You will be advised if this is the case.

As a general guide

B Grade + pony clubbers could do Class 1 or 2
 C Grade pony clubbers could do Class 2 or 3
 D Grade pony clubbers could do class 3 or 4
 E Grade pony clubbers could do class 4 or 5

We ask all riders to please compete in a fair height with your combination.
 i.e. if you are a D Grade Pony Club Combination please do not compete in the 50cm section.
 We also ask you to not go the other way and overface your horse if you or he is not ready
 Fairness to everyone makes the sport enjoyable

1st—10 Points	2nd—9 points	3rd—8 points	4th—7points	5th—6 points

SCORING SYSTEM:

Points will be awarded as follows:

TEAM Scoring—Points scored by all 3 team members are to count. Should a team member be forced to scratch, they may be replaced by an individual from the same school, PRIOR to the commencement of competition.

Each team rider will have their scores calculated over the duration of the competition. Upon completion of the three classes, the team with the highest score will be awarded the title of INTERSCHOOL SHOWJUMPING CHAMPIONS.

Count back will be based on AM7 result i.e. placing and if still level will go to time.

INDIVIDUAL Scoring—classes may be split into 2 sections with ribbon placing's 1st to 6th for each section depending on numbers. TO DETERMINE THE OVERALL INDIVIDUAL WINNER these sections will be combined and based on the above count back system.

CLASS 1 and 2 will be combined on a handicapped system if numbers are small for points.
